







I COMPLETED ALL MY PRIOR STUDIES IN ENGLISH. IS IT STILL NECESSARY FOR ME TO TAKE THE IELTS/TOEFL EXAM?

The English proficiency examination requirement is determined by your nationality rather than your place of study. Applicants who are not citizens of native English-speaking countries are kindly requested to complete an English proficiency examination. You may submit your application without the exam but are required to provide your examination result one month before the academic program starts.

Yes, we invite you to upload a Word document containing your diploma, along with a brief statement specifying your expected graduation date. Additionally, please upload all available transcripts pertaining to your current academic progress; this will provide us with the necessary information to process your application.

WHAT IS THE A-HES SUBSIDY?

The A-HES subsidy is a financial agreement between EHL and the Haute École Spécialisée de Suisse occidentale (HES-SO), under which HES-SO partially covers the tuition for eligible MiHM students. If you are eligible, your tuition will be limited to **CHF 700 per academic semester**, the remainder being paid by the HES-SO (additional costs such as infrastructure, services, or catering packages are excluded).

WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR THE A-HES SUBSIDY

To benefit from this subsidy, students must meet one of the following criteria at the time of enrollment:

- Students with Swiss nationality whose parents reside in Switzerland.
- Swiss nationals living abroad or whose parents live abroad.
- Refugees or stateless individuals assigned to a canton in Switzerland.
- Permanent residents who have lived and worked full-time in the same Swiss canton for at least two years, achieving financial independence.
- Foreign students with civil residence in Switzerland (excluding B permits for education purposes).
- Foreign students with parents or legal guardians residing in Switzerland.
- Foreign students whose parents live abroad but at least one parent works in Geneva under a G permit.

Eligibility is determined by the relevant canton under the Intercantonal Agreement on Universities of Applied Sciences (A-HES).

CAN MY ELIGIBILITY STATUS CHANGE DURING MY STUDIES?

The questionnaire determining the granting of A-HES status will be sent to students one month before the start of the academic year. Once defined, the status remains unchanged for the whole duration of studies.

WHAT HAPPENS IF I ABANDON OR FAIL THE PROGRAM?

If you abandon your studies or fail before October 15, depending on the semester in progress, you will lose your funding, and the HES-SO will stop contributing to your tuition. In this case, the full tuition for international students will be applicable and be invoiced.

IS THE TUITION CHARGED PER SEMESTER OR FOR THE ENTIRE PROGRAM?

The tuition is calculated and payable for the entire duration of the program.

IS IT POSSIBLE TO PAY MY TUITION IN INSTALMENTS?

Yes, our Finance department will be able to assist you once you get accepted for the program after the interview.

The program fees remain consistent irrespective of the student's origin. However, students eligible for the A-HES subsidy will pay reduced tuition. Please refer to the A-HES subsidy eligibility criteria to determine if you qualify.

IS ACCOMMODATION INCLUDED IN THE TUITION? IF NOT, WHAT WOULD BE THE ESTIMATED MONTHLY COST?

No, typically, students can anticipate an average monthly expenditure of approximately CHF 1,500 per month throughout the program duration. Accommodation fees may vary based on the host country and should be clearly outlined for each new semester.

IS ON-CAMPUS ACCOMMODATION AVAILABLE FOR MASTER'S STUDENTS?

While we do offer a substantial number of on-campus rooms for students, availability is not guaranteed.

Due to high demand, rooms are allocated on a **first-come, first-served basis**. We therefore encourage master's candidates to apply early and explore off-campus housing options in parallel.
